## **ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

**ORDERED** that the motion for protective order be and it hereby is **GRANTED**, and it is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the defendants may not ask any plaintiff or witness any questions or request any documents relating to the immigration status of the plaintiff or the witness, or to the immigration status of any other plaintiff or witness or other person affiliated with a plaintiff or a witness in this case. Examples of such prohibited inquiries include questions about immigration status, birthplace, entry into the United States, social security numbers or cards, a "green card" or alien residence card, passports, driver's licenses, and any other inquiry intended to elicit information with regard to the immigration status of a plaintiff, witness, or person affiliated with a plaintiff or witness in this case.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any Notice of Deposition or Subpoena served on any fact witness in this case shall include a copy of this Order, and at the beginning of any deposition of a fact witness in this case, this Order shall be read to the witness.
